Christians celebrate victory over Pro-Abortion Bill

This week in the 42 Members NSW Upper House (Legislative Council) the Green Party radical Pro-Abortion Bill was overwhelmingly defeated by 25 to 14 votes - Praise God!

The Green Party Bill had a large number of objectionable features such as:

- Repeal all Pro-Life legal protections in the Bill
- Repeal the Common Law, which protects the unborn babies of NSW
- Force Doctors to refer for abortions against their conscience
- Establish 150m exclusion zone around Abortion Clinics in NSW (where Christians can be fined if they pray or seek to protect unborn babies)

Global Interaction - May Mission Month 2017

There are five couples/families ready to go to Cambodia. Before they can go, they need to raise their support, which they are finding difficult. This is holding them back and therefore holding back the Gospel from reaching Khmer people.
