

As today is Sam's last Sunday before he goes to Africa on Mission, we asked Sam a couple of Questions about his time here at Maroubra Baptist.

1. What did you enjoy about Maroubra Baptist Church?

Even more than the music, I loved meeting new people, reconnecting with old people and building my relationship with God all under the preaching of Neil for the time that I've been with you guys.

2. Were there any memorable moments?

Some of my most fond and memorable moments include, but not limited to, are:

- Seeing all your faces week in and week out from the front*
 - The end of 100 days of prayer worship night.*
 - Every day for 100 days receiving a prayer from Neil*
 - Chicken and chips with the Steinies*
 - Meeting Sylvia who was on welcoming, for the first time.*
 - Never receiving the same handshake from Jaxon, but always the same type of encouragement which pushed me to think and challenge myself*
 - receiving a last minute call, text or email from someone asking what the songs are for tomorrow*
