Open Doors

This morning, we welcome Tim from Open Doors, who will share from God's word and give testimony to

God's great blessing. Open Doors work in over 70 countries to support Christians who are persecuted for their faith in Jesus. Open Doors partner with local churches in places where faith costs the most. Last year, they trained over 450,000 persecuted Christians in church leadership and discipleship. In 2016, Open Doors provided jobs, health care, safe houses, emergency food and more to over 870,000 people and delivered over 2.5 million Bibles and Christian literature around the world.

Capernwray 5 - 13 May

We welcome Ryan, Melissa and the team from Capernwray, who will be ministering with us at Maroubra this week. Capernwray Australia is a bible school, located in Moss Vale, NSW. They host a large number of Young Adults from overseas at their Bible School and offer a Road-Trip for six weeks with one of the experienced ministry leaders. After a week of orientation and preparation on campus, they hit the road for the next four to five weeks. We make up one of those weeks.

Capernwray Torchbearers is international and interdenominational and is supported and endorsed by all major denominations and church groups throughout the world. Capernwray Torchbearers was established in England after World War II under the direction of Major Ian Thomas. The spiritual vacuum in the lives of those affected by war, both English and German, was apparent. The ministry extended to Europe and now operates in many countries around the world, including Germany, Austria, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, USA, Canada, Indonesia, India, NZ, Japan, Costa Rica, Phillipines, Malaysia and Australia.
