Mr Eternity - Author Talks Tues 5 June

Join author Roy Williams as he discusses his book 'Mr Eternity: The Story of Arthur Stace', a biography of one of Sydney's most intriguing characters, Arthur Stace, the man who inscribed the word 'Eternity' in copperplate writing on the pavements of our city. Free but bookings essential.

Arthur Stace came from the humblest of backgrounds. Born in Balmain in 1885, the neglected child of alcoholics, he was forced to steal food to survive and was made a ward of the state at age 12. This shaky foundation triggered his own inevitable descent into alcoholism. A turning point in his life came at age 45 through conversion to Christianity and the inspiration to help others on their spiritual journey. It is estimated that he chalked 'Eternity' 500,000 times over 36 years, on the footpaths of Sydney, country NSW and Melbourne.
