'A piece of cake' in memory of Sandy Gaskin



We received this email from Kimberley this week about an initiative she is organising for The Sydney Kids Hospital Child Protection Unit. We wholeheartedly support and suggest below how we can all be involved.

It's Mum's birthday on Wednesday August 1 and we want to run a little fundraiser called "A piece of cake".

The idea is to ask people to have a piece of cake on Mum's birthday to remember her...and to

donate the price of a slice or a whole cake to the Child Protection Unit at Sydney Kids Hospital.

Mum worked at the Sydney Kids Hospital Child Protection Unit for 9 years and was so passionate about her work and about the kids and families she encountered. CPU helps kids at risk of violence, neglect and abuse.

Here's how it works:

- Buy yourself a piece of cake, eat it and remember Sandy's beautiful generosity.
