

Scott Morrison - Australia's new Prime Minister




Reported from New York. Scott Morrison, 50, was raised in a beachside Sydney suburb, and his family was active in the Uniting Church of Australia when he was growing up. He met his wife, Jenny, in church when he was 12. In his maiden speech to Parliament in 2008, he described Christianity as one of his main motivations for service. "For me, faith is personal,

but the implications are social — as personal and social responsibility are at the heart of the Christian message," Mr. Morrison said in the speech, where he also cited a verse from the Book of Jeremiah as the encapsulation of the core of his beliefs: "I am the Lord who exercises loving kindness, justice and righteousness on Earth; for I delight in these things, declares the Lord." "Australia is not a secular country," he added. "It is a free country.


In an Australian article, Baird urged people of faith to pray for the new top-dog. "He'll certainly need a lot of prayer and I'm sure he'll get things wrong, but I think if the Christians are out there praying for him and recognise that he's fallible at the bottom line, but that he's trying to do his best under God, then that's a good start," he said.
