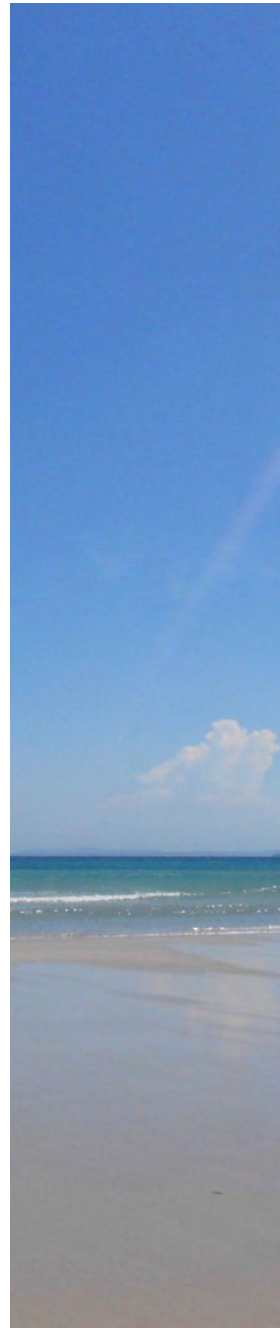

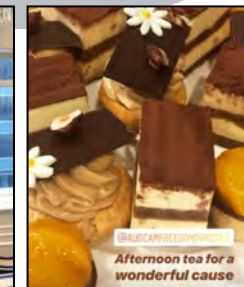


## AusCam High Tea
